

**DISTRICT EXPLORING NEW OPTION FOR
REPAIRING GREENFIELD PLACE STORM SEWERS**

The District is currently exploring a new option, offered by the Deerfield Township Trustees at its April 23, 2009 public work session, for repairing the failed storm sewer pipes in Greenfield Place. The Deerfield Township Trustees recently received a proposal from the contractor who originally installed the pipe to replace all the collapsed and some of the failed pipe eliminating the existing sinkholes at a greatly reduced cost. This option was not previously available to the District and its details are currently under examination by the District. **While the District Board completes its review of this option, residents should assume that the original construction plans and the assessment are proceeding as planned. Residents who intend to object to their estimated assessment should still do so according to the information contained in the letter sent to them by the District via certified mail.** Again, many questions remain about this potential new option and all of the details are not yet known by the District. Please understand that while the District explores this option, we will simultaneously be proceeding with our original plans, which includes preparing for the assessment. To be clear, this notice is NOT an announcement that the District has elected to choose the new option nor is it an announcement that the proposed special assessment will not be levied. If the District pursues an option which results in the reduction or elimination of the proposed special assessment, we will advise the property owners of the same.
